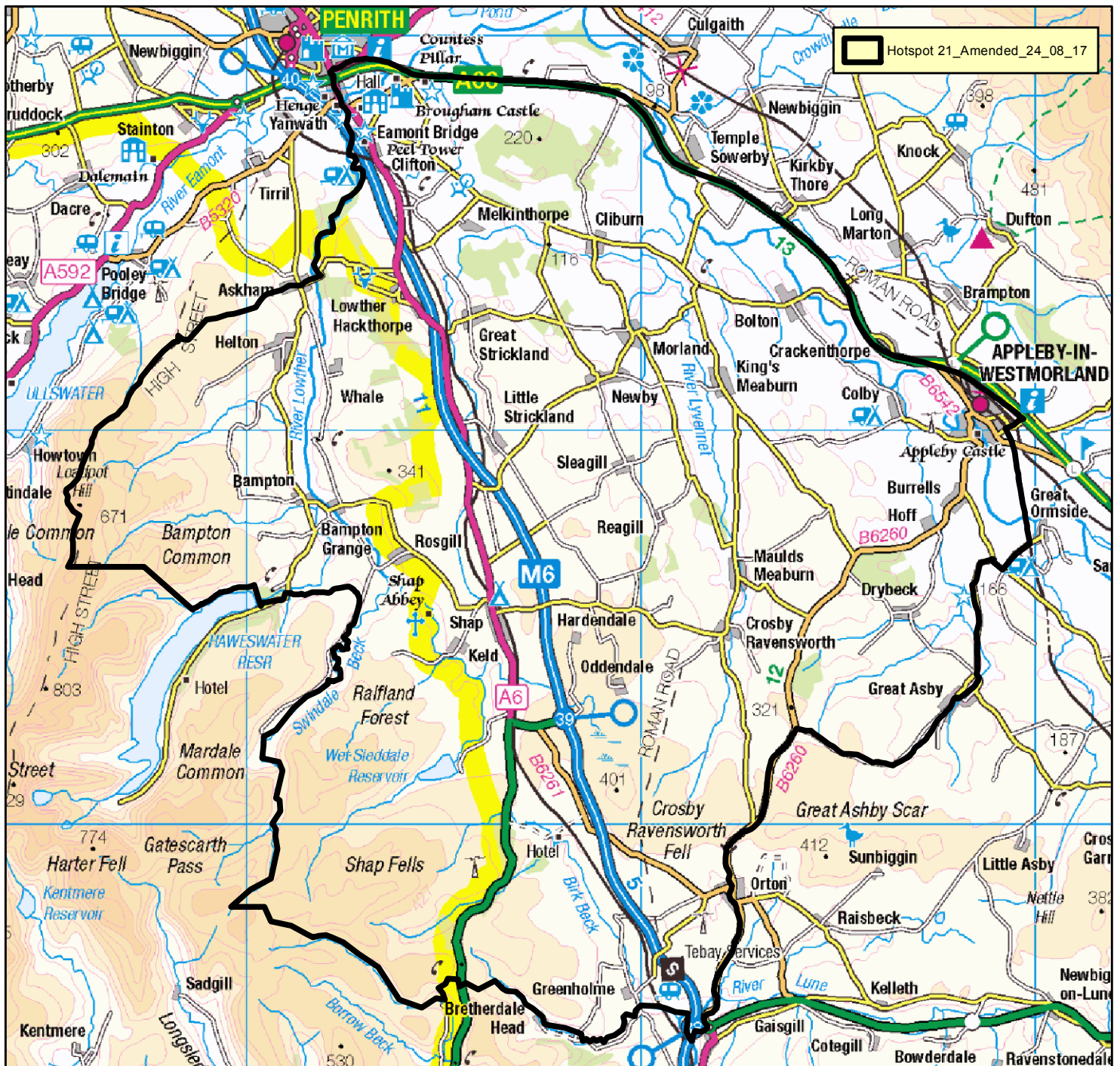


Cumbrian 17z bTB Cluster Premises 2014-2017

OFFICIAL SENSITIVE



From Penrith the boundary follows the A66 to Appleby in Westmorland. At Appleby follow Cross Croft to the right of A66. Until the intersection of the railway line near Courtfield Garage. Boundary then follows the railway to Great Ormside Station. The boundary then follows an un-named road that passes Wild Rose Caravan Park until Helm Lane is reached. It goes along Helm Lane to the right until Broadmire Road on left. It then follows Broadmire Road towards Great Asby & Sayle Lane until it joins the B6260 - which goes through to Orton to A685 at Old Tebay. At junction 38 of M6 the boundary joins Bretherdale Beck and path towards Bretherdale Head and up Bretherdale Bank until it reaches the A6. Across the A6, following the same path to Crookdale Beck and from here, along the beck all the way up to Harrop Pike. On the other side of Harrop Pike boundary goes northbound along Little Mosedale Beck, Mosedale Beck and Swindale Beck just until it reaches the road north of Tailbert. It now follows this road for approx. 2 miles, turning left at the junction in front of "Naddle Gate" continuing to Haweswater reservoir. Once this road meets the reservoir the boundary then turns right along the dyke in Haweswater and follows the reservoir northern shore until the Waterfalls. From this point, the boundary continues in a north-westerly direction onto Bampton Common the over the fell tops of Low Kop, Wether Top, Loadpot Hill to the track at Barton Fell. The boundary then turns in a north-easterly direction to Askham up until River Lowther. It now follows the river northbound, going under the M6 until it meets the A6 from where the boundary goes northbound to the roundabout to join the A66.
